RESCUE DIVER COURSE

We don't like to think about it but accidents happen. There are several good reasons that Rescue training expands your knowledge of diving, increases your level of diving skill, and makes you more aware of what is happening around you in the diving environment.

Rescue Diver certification is a prerequisite for the PADI Divernaster rating and the distinguished PADI Master Scuba Diver certification.

Most importantly, Rescue training can help you recognize and respond properly to potential diving emergencies in the very unlikely event that they should occur.

Course content

The Rescue course is run over two days and consists of home study, knowledge development, multiple choice exam, confined water training and open water dives.

In the classroom you will cover 5 modules:

- First Aid
- Equipment
- Self and Buddy Rescue Assists & Rescues
- · Scene Management

In the pool you will cover 10 rescue and self rescue exercises. You will then combine all of this new found knowledge, and demonstrate these skills in 2 realistic open water scenarios.

Course Prerequisites

Minimum age 12 years old. PADI (Jr.) Adventure Open Water Diver who have completed the Underwater Navigation Adventure Dive.

First-aid requirement: As part of the Rescue course you will be required to hold a current first aid and C.P.R certification completed in the last two years. This is where the Emergency First Response Course comes in.



EMERGENCY FIRST RESPONSE



First aid and CPR are good skills for anyone to learn, especially those involved in adventure sports - just in case. The Emergency First Response course is a one day classroom based course and meets the First Aid training required as part of the PADI Rescue Diver course.
